Study Skills Workshops

SLS Librarians offer a Study Skills Workshop that aims to cover topics such as plagiarism and effective research. Although very useful to older students embarking on their exams at secondary school, these sessions can also be tailored for a younger audience. An emphasis is placed on the fact that these skills can be carried from primary through to secondary school, and beyond.
